
Individual Care

Onslow is known for its individual support. Our International Student Department has an "open door" approach to their students. This means students are welcome to meet with us at any time and we work hard at providing them with high quality care, a suitable academic course and regular social activities. We provide bilingual support when it is necessary.

Our Programme

A wide range of subjects are available including Digital Technology, Earth and Space Science, Accounting, Economics, Photography, Media Studies and Art Design. There is a wide choice of languages for our students to learn: French, Maori, Spanish, Japanese and Chinese. We also have short term courses for students who are not sitting our school examinations. These include Café Cuisine, New Zealand Studies, Sewing for Beginners, electronics and Outdoor Education.

Many Different Opportunities

Onslow College offers a choice of over 30 sports and numerous cultural activities in which students can participate. These include athletics, badminton, basketball, soccer, tennis, rugby, mountain biking, shooting, volleyball, touch rugby, rowing and orienteering. We have school choirs, a school production, many school bands and a school orchestra. Individual music tuition is also available.

Many Outdoor Education Experiences

Our February orientation programme introduces our international students to the outdoors. The students can experience surfing, rafting, high ropes and abseiling. We also offer an outdoor education course in year 12 that includes kayaking, mountain biking, tramping, sailing, rock climbing and a high ropes course.

Our Academic Success

Onslow offers the NCEA (National Certificates of Educational Achievement) qualification at all levels. Our academic results are well above the national average. We have excellent standards of teaching with academic success. Recently we have won national and international awards in Graphic Design, Spanish, Mathematics, and Physics and Chemistry. The school is also strong in Geography, Music and Drama. Most of our international students go on to attend universities of their choice or other tertiary institutions.

Student Support

English Language and Academic

The English Language Department provides high quality English language courses at all levels including IELTS. We have well qualified English language specialists who work with groups of students or individually. We support students who have English language needs by providing in class subject support for Years 9 to 11 students. We also provide support classes each week for senior Mathematics and Year 11 Science students.

Homestays

Our homestay programme aims to provide a positive family experience for all our students. We have high standards for our homestay families and expect them to engage with the school community and meet the needs of their students.

Social Activities

As well as the school sports and cultural activities, we organise international dinners, an International food fair, sporting activities and outings during the school year.
